1-19 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
 1-20 AN ACT

1-21 relating to cancellation of certain solid waste disposal permits
 1-22 issued by the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality.

1-23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-24 SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 361, Health and Safety
 1-25 Code, is amended by adding Section 361.1201 to read as follows:

1-26 Sec. 361.1201. CANCELLATION OF CERTAIN LANDFILL PERMITS.

1-27 (a) This section applies only to a facility that is located in:

1-28 (1) a county with a population of more than 2.1
 1-29 million; and

1-30 (2) the extraterritorial jurisdiction of the county's
 1-31 principal municipality with a population of more than 900,000.

1-32 (b) The commission shall cancel a permit issued for a
 1-33 municipal solid waste landfill facility if the facility has not
 1-34 accepted waste for a period of 25 consecutive years.

1-35 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
 1-36 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
 1-37 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
 1-38 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
 1-39 Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
