1-24 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
1-25 AN ACT

1-26 relating to member contributions to the Texas Municipal Retirement
1-27 System.

1-28 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-29 SECTION 1. Section [855.401\(a\)](#), Government Code, is amended
1-30 to read as follows:

1-31 (a) Each municipality that has one or more departments
1-32 participating in the retirement system by ordinance shall designate
1-33 the rate of member contributions for employees. The municipality
1-34 shall elect a rate of five, six, ~~or~~ seven, or eight percent of the
1-35 employees' compensation. All departments of a participating
1-36 municipality must have the same employee contribution rate, except
1-37 that any municipality that before September 1, 1991, has elected to
1-38 have different rates of member contributions in different
1-39 departments may continue member contributions in accordance with
1-40 its existing ordinances until the municipality elects to equalize
1-41 the rates.

1-42 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.

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
