1-25 relating to the eligibility of members of the State Board of

 1-27 employees group benefits program.

1-28 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-29 SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 1551, Insurance Code, is
 1-30 amended by adding Section 1551.1095 to read as follows:

1-31 Sec. 1551.1095. ELIGIBILITY OF STATE BOARD OF EDUCATION
 1-32 MEMBERS. (a) Subject to Section 1551.351, on application to the
 1-33 board of trustees and arrangement for payment of contributions, an
 1-34 individual who is a member of the State Board of Education and not
 1-35 otherwise eligible under Section 1551.109 and the individual's
 1-36 dependents are eligible under this section to participate in the
 1-37 group benefits program offered under this chapter.

1-38 (b) A participant described by this section may not receive
 1-39 a state contribution for premiums.

1-40 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.

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
