1-17 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
1-18 AN ACT

1-19 relating to the designation of a portion of State Highway 6 in  
1-20 Brazos County as the Sergeant Mark Butler Memorial Highway.

1-21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-22 SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 225, Transportation Code,  
1-23 is amended by adding Section 225.249 to read as follows:

1-24 Sec. 225.249. SERGEANT MARK BUTLER MEMORIAL HIGHWAY. (a)  
1-25 The portion of State Highway 6 in Brazos County between the southern  
1-26 municipal limits of College Station and the northern municipal  
1-27 limits of Navasota is designated as the Sergeant Mark Butler  
1-28 Memorial Highway. The designation is in addition to any other  
1-29 designation.

1-30 (b) Subject to Section 225.021(c), the department shall:

1-31 (1) design and construct markers indicating the  
1-32 designation as the Sergeant Mark Butler Memorial Highway and any  
1-33 other appropriate information; and

1-34 (2) erect a marker at each end of the highway and at  
1-35 appropriate intermediate sites along the highway.

1-36 SECTION 2. It is the intention of the 89th Legislature,  
1-37 Regular Session, 2025, that the provisions added by this Act be  
1-38 renumbered to prevent multiple provisions with the same  
1-39 designation.

1-40 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
