1-17 relating to the composition, duties, and personnel of the Moore
1-18 County Juvenile Board.

1-19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-20 SECTION 1. Sections 152.1771(a), (b), and (f), Human
1-21 Resources Code, are amended to read as follows:

1-22 (a) The Moore County Juvenile Board is composed of:

1-23 (1) the county judge;

1-24 (2) the judge of the County Court at Law of Moore
1-25 County; and

1-26 (3) not fewer than three or more than five other
1-27 members ~~[(2) six persons]~~ appointed by the Moore County
1-28 Commissioners Court.

1-29 (b) The appointed members serve ~~[staggered]~~ two-year terms
1-30 ~~[with the terms of three members]~~ expiring on December 31 of each
1-31 even-numbered year unless the Moore County Commissioners Court
1-32 votes to extend a member's term for not more than two years~~[, and~~
1-33 ~~the terms of three members expiring on December 31 of each~~
1-34 ~~odd-numbered year]~~.

1-35 (f) Sections 152.0002, 152.0003, 152.0004, 152.0005, and
1-36 152.0006~~[, 152.0007, and 152.0008]~~ do not apply to the juvenile
1-37 board of Moore County.

1-38 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.

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
