1-17 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
 1-18 AN ACT

1-19 relating to the licensing of mental hospitals and mental health
 1-20 facilities and the definition of facility for the purposes of the
 1-21 employee misconduct registry.

1-22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-23 SECTION 1. Section 253.001(4), Health and Safety Code, as
 1-24 amended by Chapters 674 (H.B. 1009) and 887 (H.B. 4696), Acts of the
 1-25 88th Legislature, Regular Session, 2023, is reenacted and amended
 1-26 to read as follows:

1-27 (4) "Facility" means:

1-28 (A) a nursing facility licensed by the
 1-29 commission under Chapter 242;

1-30 (B) an intermediate care facility for
 1-31 individuals with an intellectual disability licensed by the
 1-32 commission under Chapter 252;

1-33 (C) an adult foster care provider that contracts
 1-34 with the commission;

1-35 (D) a home and community support services agency
 1-36 licensed by the commission under Chapter 142;

1-37 (E) a prescribed pediatric extended care center
 1-38 licensed by the commission under Chapter 248A;

1-39 (F) an assisted living facility licensed by the
 1-40 commission under Chapter 247;

1-41 (F-1) a facility licensed under Chapter 555;

1-42 (F-2) a facility licensed under Chapter 577;

1-43 (G) a day activity and health services facility
 1-44 licensed by the commission under Chapter 103, Human Resources Code;

1-45 (H) a residential child-care facility as defined
 1-46 by Section 42.002, Human Resources Code, at which an elderly person
 1-47 or an adult with a disability resides or is in the facility's care;

1-48 (I) a provider who provides home and
 1-49 community-based services under the home and community-based
 1-50 services (HCS) waiver program or the Texas home living (TxHmL)
 1-51 waiver program; or

1-52 (J) a facility that is exempt from licensure
 1-53 under Section 252.003.

1-54 SECTION 2. Section 577.004(d), Health and Safety Code, is
 1-55 amended to read as follows:

1-56 (d) The application must contain:

1-57 (1) the name and location of the mental hospital or
 1-58 mental health facility;

1-59 (2) the name and address of the physician to be in
 1-60 charge of the hospital care and treatment of the patients;

1-61 (3) the names and addresses of the mental hospital

2-1 owners, including the officers, directors, and principal
2-2 stockholders if the owner is a corporation or other association, or
2-3 the names and addresses of the members of the board of trustees of
2-4 the community center or the directors of the entity designated by
2-5 the department to provide mental health services;

2-6 (4) the bed capacity to be authorized by the license;
2-7 (5) the number, duties, and qualifications of the
2-8 professional staff;

2-9 (6) a description of the equipment and facilities of
2-10 the mental hospital or mental health facility; ~~and~~

2-11 (7) the name and address of the person responsible for
2-12 the daily operations of the mental hospital or mental health
2-13 facility; and

2-14 (8) other information required by the department,
2-15 including affirmative evidence of ability to comply with the
2-16 department's rules and standards.

2-17 SECTION 3. The Health and Human Services Commission is
2-18 required to implement a provision of this Act only if the
2-19 legislature appropriates money specifically for that purpose. If
2-20 the legislature does not appropriate money for that purpose, the
2-21 commission may, but is not required to, implement a provision of
2-22 this Act using other money available for that purpose.

2-23 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
