1-19 relating to restrictions on the fee assessed for issuance of
 1-20 certain birth records.

1-21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-22 SECTION 1. Section 191.0046, Health and Safety Code, is
 1-23 amended by adding Subsection (g) to read as follows:

1-24 (g) The state registrar, a local registrar, or a county
 1-25 clerk, on request of a county or a child welfare board appointed by
 1-26 the commissioners court of a county under Section 264.005, Family
 1-27 Code, shall issue without a fee a certified copy of a birth record
 1-28 to the county or board if the request is related to a suit affecting
 1-29 the parent-child relationship filed by a governmental entity under
 1-30 Subtitle E, Title 5, Family Code.

1-31 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
