1-17 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
1-18 AN ACT

1-19 relating to the revocation of a driver's license or personal  
1-20 identification certificate and to disqualification from operating  
1-21 a commercial motor vehicle.

1-22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-23 SECTION 1. Section 521.101(h), Transportation Code, is  
1-24 amended to read as follows:

1-25 (h) The department shall automatically revoke each personal  
1-26 identification certificate issued by the department to a person  
1-27 who:

1-28 (1) is subject to the registration requirements of  
1-29 Chapter 62 or 65, Code of Criminal Procedure; and

1-30 (2) fails to apply to the department for renewal of the  
1-31 personal identification certificate as required by Article 62.060,  
1-32 ~~or~~ 62.2021, or 65.058, Code of Criminal Procedure, as applicable.

1-33 SECTION 2. The heading to Section 521.348, Transportation  
1-34 Code, is amended to read as follows:

1-35 Sec. 521.348. AUTOMATIC REVOCATION FOR CERTAIN SEX  
1-36 OFFENDERS AND TERRORISTS.

1-37 SECTION 3. Section 521.348(a), Transportation Code, is  
1-38 amended to read as follows:

1-39 (a) A driver's license is automatically revoked if the  
1-40 holder of the license:

1-41 (1) is subject to the registration requirements of  
1-42 Chapter 62 or 65, Code of Criminal Procedure; and

1-43 (2) fails to apply to the department for renewal of the  
1-44 license as required by Article 62.060, ~~or~~ 62.2021, or 65.058,  
1-45 Code of Criminal Procedure, as applicable.

1-46 SECTION 4. The following provisions of the Transportation  
1-47 Code are repealed:

1-48 (1) Section 521.297(b); and

1-49 (2) Section 522.087(b).

1-50 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
