1-15 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
 1-16 AN ACT

1-17 relating to certain authorities of the adjutant general for
 1-18 procurement and construction.

1-19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-20 SECTION 1. Section 437.054(a), Government Code, is amended
 1-21 to read as follows:

1-22 (a) The adjutant general is the decision-making authority
 1-23 on all matters concerning the location and maintenance of military
 1-24 forces and facilities in this state. The adjutant general may set
 1-25 priorities for the construction, renovation, repair, and
 1-26 maintenance of Texas military forces armories, facilities, and
 1-27 improvements owned or leased by this state. The adjutant general in
 1-28 this capacity is a public authority and a body politic and corporate
 1-29 and has all powers necessary for the acquisition and procurement
 1-30 related to construction, construction, rental, control,
 1-31 maintenance, operation, and disposition of Texas military forces
 1-32 facilities and real property and all associated property and
 1-33 equipment.

1-34 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.

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
