1-16 AN ACT

1-17 relating to the adoption of uniform rules for hours of work for
1-18 certain county employees.
1-19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
1-20 SECTION 1. Section 157.021(a), Local Government Code, is
1-21 amended to read as follows:
1-22 (a) In a county with a population of 265,000 [~~355,000~~] or
1-23 more, the commissioners court may adopt and enforce uniform rules
1-24 on the hours of work of department heads, assistants, deputies, and
1-25 other employees whose compensation is set or approved by the court.
1-26 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
1-27 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
1-28 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
1-29 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
1-30 Act takes effect September 1, 2025.

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
