1-19 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
1-20 AN ACT

1-21 relating to authorizing certain municipalities to change the date  
1-22 on which their general election for officers is held.

1-23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-24 SECTION 1. Section 41.0052, Election Code, is amended by  
1-25 adding Subsection (a-3) to read as follows:

1-26 (a-3) Notwithstanding Subsection (a), a municipality on the  
1-27 Texas-Mexico border with a population of more than 85,000 that  
1-28 hosts the annual Texas Citrus Fiesta and holds its general election  
1-29 for officers on a date other than the November uniform election date  
1-30 may change the date on which it holds its general election for  
1-31 officers to the November uniform election date. A municipality  
1-32 described by this subsection that changes the date of its election  
1-33 under this subsection may not change the date on which it holds its  
1-34 general election for officers to a date other than the November  
1-35 uniform election date.

1-36 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
