1-18 AN ACT

1-19 relating to grant amounts under the young farmer grant program.
1-20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
1-21 SECTION 1. Section 58.093, Agriculture Code, is amended to
1-22 read as follows:
1-23 Sec. 58.093. AMOUNT OF GRANTS. A grant under the young
1-24 farmer grant program may not be less than \$10,000 [~~\$5,000~~] or more
1-25 than \$35,000 [~~\$20,000~~].
1-26 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies to a
1-27 grant issued on or after the effective date of this Act. A grant
1-28 issued before the effective date of this Act is governed by the law
1-29 in effect on the date the grant is issued, and the former law is
1-30 continued in effect for that purpose.
1-31 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
