1-17 relating to an annual study on the economic, environmental, and
1-18 financial impact of illegal immigration in this state.

1-19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-20 SECTION 1. Chapter 752, Government Code, is amended by
1-21 adding Subchapter D to read as follows:

1-22 SUBCHAPTER D. STUDY ON IMPACT OF ILLEGAL IMMIGRATION

1-23 Sec. 752.101. ANNUAL IMMIGRATION IMPACT STUDY. (a) The
1-24 office of the governor shall conduct an annual study on the
1-25 economic, environmental, and financial impact of illegal
1-26 immigration in this state.

1-27 (b) The office of the governor may collaborate or contract
1-28 with a state or federal agency, a political subdivision, an
1-29 institution of higher education, or a nonprofit organization or
1-30 other private entity to assist in conducting the study required by
1-31 this section.

1-32 Sec. 752.102. BIENNIAL REPORT. Not later than December 1 of
1-33 each even-numbered year, the office of the governor shall prepare
1-34 and submit to the lieutenant governor and legislature a report
1-35 containing the results of each study conducted in the preceding two
1-36 years under this subchapter.

1-37 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.

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
