 1-19 AN ACT

1-20 relating to the definition of a crosswalk.
 1-21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
 1-22 SECTION 1. Section [541.302\(2\)](#), Transportation Code, is
 1-23 amended to read as follows:
 1-24 (2) "Crosswalk" means:
 1-25 (A) the portion of a roadway, including an
 1-26 intersection, designated as a pedestrian crossing by surface
 1-27 markings, including lines; ~~or~~
 1-28 (B) the portion of a roadway at an intersection
 1-29 that is within the connections of the lateral lines of the sidewalks
 1-30 on opposite sides of the highway measured from the curbs or, in the
 1-31 absence of curbs, from the edges of the traversable roadway; or
 1-32 (C) where sidewalks run parallel to a roadway and
 1-33 are interrupted by a driveway, the portion of the driveway that is
 1-34 within the connections of the lateral lines of the sidewalks on
 1-35 opposite sides of the driveway.
 1-36 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
 1-37 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
 1-38 provided by Section [39](#), Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
 1-39 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
 1-40 Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
