A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1-21 1-22 AN ACT

relating to exempting certain transactions from regulation by the 1-23 1-24 Texas Real Estate Commission. 1-25

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

SECTION 1. Section 1101.002, Occupations Code, is amended by adding Subdivisions (4-a) and (4-b) to read as follows: (4-a) "Mineral" has the meaning assigned by Section

Property Code. The term includes oil, gas, related 75.001 hydrocarbons, coal, lignite, uranium, and substances classified as

base, industrial, precious, or strategic minerals.
(4-b) "Other energy source" means a natural resource other than water or a mineral that is necessary to produce energy, including geothermal, nuclear, solar, and wind energy.

SECTION 2. Section 1101.005, Occupations Code, is amended to read as follows:

APPLICABILITY OF CHAPTER. This chapter does Sec. 1101.005. not apply to:

- (1)an attorney licensed in this state;
- (2) an attorney-in-fact authorized under a power of attorney to conduct not more than three real estate transactions annually;
- a public official while engaged in official (3) duties;
- an auctioneer licensed under Chapter 1802 while (4) conducting the sale of real estate by auction if the auctioneer does not perform another act of a broker;
- (5) a person conducting a real estate transaction under a court order or the authority of a will or written trust instrument;
- (6) a person employed by an owner in the sale of and land on which structures are located if the structures structures are erected by the owner in the course of the owner's business;
