1-21 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
1-22 AN ACT

1-23 relating to the development of a standard method of computing a  
1-24 student's high school grade point average.

1-25 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-26 SECTION 1. Sections 28.0252(a) and (b), Education Code, are  
1-27 amended to read as follows:

1-28 (a) The commissioner shall ~~[may]~~ develop a standard method  
1-29 of computing a student's high school grade point average that  
1-30 provides for additional weight to be given to each honors course,  
1-31 advanced placement course, international baccalaureate course,  
1-32 OnRamps dual enrollment course, or dual credit course completed by  
1-33 a student. The method must provide for an equal amount of  
1-34 additional weight to be given to an advanced placement course, an  
1-35 international baccalaureate course, an OnRamps dual enrollment  
1-36 course, and a dual credit course.

1-37 (b) ~~A [If the commissioner develops a standard method under~~  
1-38 ~~this section, a] school district shall use the standard method~~  
1-39 ~~developed by the commissioner under Subsection (a) to compute a~~  
1-40 ~~student's high school grade point average.~~

1-41 SECTION 2. As soon as practicable after the effective date  
1-42 of this Act, the commissioner of education shall develop a standard  
1-43 method of computing a student's high school grade point average as  
1-44 required by Section 28.0252(a), Education Code, as amended by this  
1-45 Act.

1-46 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives  
1-47 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as  
1-48 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this  
1-49 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this  
1-50 Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
