1-17 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
1-18 AN ACT

1-19 relating to the designation of a portion of U.S. Highway 69 in Smith
1-20 County as the Veterans Memorial Highway.

1-21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-22 SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 225, Transportation Code,
1-23 is amended by adding Section 225.243 to read as follows:

1-24 Sec. 225.243. VETERANS MEMORIAL HIGHWAY. (a) The portion
1-25 of U.S. Highway 69 in Smith County between its intersection with
1-26 South State Loop 323 and its intersection with the northern
1-27 municipal limits of Bullard is designated as the Veterans Memorial
1-28 Highway. The designation is in addition to any other designation.

1-29 (b) Subject to Section 225.021(c), the department shall:

1-30 (1) design and construct markers indicating the
1-31 designation as the Veterans Memorial Highway and any other
1-32 appropriate information; and

1-33 (2) erect a marker at each end of the highway and at
1-34 appropriate intermediate sites along the highway.

1-35 SECTION 2. It is the intention of the 89th Legislature,
1-36 Regular Session, 2025, that the provisions added by this Act be
1-37 renumbered to prevent multiple provisions with the same
1-38 designation.

1-39 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
