1-17 relating to the dissolution of a public utility agency.
1-18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
1-19 SECTION 1. Section [572.053](#), Local Government Code, is
1-20 amended to read as follows:
1-21 Sec. 572.053. CHANGES IN PUBLIC ENTITIES PARTICIPATING IN
1-22 OR DISSOLUTION OF PUBLIC UTILITY AGENCY. (a) The public entities
1-23 that participate in a public utility agency may by concurrent
1-24 ordinances:
1-25 (1) add a public entity to, or delete a public entity
1-26 from, participation in the public utility agency; or
1-27 (2) dissolve the public utility agency and transfer
1-28 all obligations, assets, permits, and licenses of the public
1-29 utility agency to the remaining public entities.
1-30 (b) A public entity that is the only remaining participant
1-31 in a public utility agency may by ordinance dissolve the public
1-32 utility agency in accordance with Subsection (a)(2).
1-33 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.

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
