1-21 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
1-22 AN ACT

1-23 relating to contracting by public and private schools for the
1-24 provision of medication for respiratory distress and training in
1-25 administering that medication.

1-26 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-27 SECTION 1. Subchapter E, Chapter 38, Education Code, is
1-28 amended by adding Section 38.2115 to read as follows:

1-29 Sec. 38.2115. CONTRACTING FOR MEDICATION FOR RESPIRATORY
1-30 DISTRESS AND TRAINING. The board of trustees of a school district
1-31 or governing body of an open-enrollment charter school or private
1-32 school may contract with a vendor to provide:

1-33 (1) medication for respiratory distress and related
1-34 equipment to the district or school; and

1-35 (2) training to school personnel and school volunteers
1-36 authorized to administer medication for respiratory distress under
1-37 this subchapter.

1-38 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
1-39 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
1-40 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
1-41 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
1-42 Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
