1-17 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
1-18 AN ACT

1-19 relating to the designation of a portion of State Highway 11 in
1-20 Morris County as the Army Staff Sergeant Samuel T. Castle Memorial
1-21 Highway.

1-22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-23 SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 225, Transportation Code,
1-24 is amended by adding Section 225.243 to read as follows:

1-25 Sec. 225.243. ARMY STAFF SERGEANT SAMUEL T. CASTLE MEMORIAL
1-26 HIGHWAY. (a) The portion of State Highway 11 in Morris County
1-27 between the eastern municipal limits of Daingerfield and the
1-28 western municipal limits of Hughes Springs is designated as the
1-29 Army Staff Sergeant Samuel T. Castle Memorial Highway. The
1-30 designation is in addition to any other designation.

1-31 (b) Subject to Section 225.021(c), the department shall:

1-32 (1) design and construct markers indicating the
1-33 designation as the Army Staff Sergeant Samuel T. Castle Memorial
1-34 Highway and any other appropriate information; and

1-35 (2) erect a marker at each end of the highway and at
1-36 appropriate intermediate sites along the highway.

1-37 SECTION 2. It is the intention of the 89th Legislature,
1-38 Regular Session, 2025, that the provisions added by this Act be
1-39 renumbered to prevent multiple provisions with the same
1-40 designation.

1-41 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
