1-20 AN ACT

1-21 relating to the supervision requirements of a code enforcement  
1-22 officer in training.

1-23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-24 SECTION 1. Section 1952.103(c), Occupations Code, is  
1-25 amended to read as follows:

1-26 (c) Except as otherwise provided by this subsection, a [A]  
1-27 code enforcement officer in training may engage in code enforcement  
1-28 under the supervision of a registered code enforcement officer. If  
1-29 the employer of the code enforcement officer in training does not  
1-30 also employ a registered code enforcement officer, the officer in  
1-31 training may engage in code enforcement without supervision.

1-32 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives  
1-33 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as  
1-34 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this  
1-35 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this  
1-36 Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
