1-21 relating to adult high school charter program funding.
1-22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
1-23 SECTION 1. Section 12.263(b), Education Code, is amended to
1-24 read as follows:
1-25 (b) For purposes of determining the average daily
1-26 attendance of an adult education program operated under a charter
1-27 granted under this subchapter, a student is considered to be in
1-28 average daily attendance, with a 100 percent attendance rate, for:
1-29 (1) all of the instructional days of the school year,
1-30 if the student is enrolled for at least 75 percent of the school
1-31 year;
1-32 (2) three-quarters [~~half~~] of the instructional days of
1-33 the school year, if the student is enrolled for at least 50 percent
1-34 but less than 75 percent of the school year;
1-35 (3) half [~~a quarter~~] of the instructional days of the
1-36 school year, if the student is enrolled for at least 25 percent but
1-37 less than 50 percent of the school year; or
1-38 (4) a quarter [~~one-tenth~~] of the instructional days of
1-39 the school year, if the student is enrolled for at least 10 percent
1-40 but less than 25 percent of the school year.
1-41 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
