1-17 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1-18 AN ACT

relating to the search of certain wireless communications devices 1-19 by a peace officer. 1-20

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

SECTION 1. Article 18.0215(a), Code of Criminal Procedure, is amended to read as follows:

(a) A peace officer may not search a person's cellular telephone or other wireless communications device, pursuant to a lawful arrest of the person without obtaining a warrant under this A wireless communications device does not include a article. skimmer as defined by Section 607.001, Business & Commerce Code, or a device manufactured for the purpose of illicitly obtaining payment card information or identifying information.

SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
