BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-22 1-23 SECTION 1. Section 26.408(b), Water Code, is amended to read as follows:

1-24 (b) As soon as practicable but not [Not] later than the 30th 1-25 day after the date the commission receives notice under Subsection 1-26 (a) or obtains independent knowledge of groundwater contamination, the commission shall make every effort to give notice of the contamination by first class mail, e-mail, notice placed on the door of a residence, or another effective delivery method to: 1-27 1-28 the 1-29 1-30

(1) each owner of a private drinking water well that 1-31 may be affected by the contamination;

(2) [and to] each applicable groundwater conservation 1-32 1-33 district; and

the residents of each residential address within 1-34 (3)1-35 one mile of the site of the contamination. 1-36

SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.

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
