1-17 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
1-18 AN ACT

1-19 relating to notification procedures concerning groundwater  
1-20 contamination.

1-21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-22 SECTION 1. Section 26.408(b), Water Code, is amended to  
1-23 read as follows:

1-24 (b) As soon as practicable but not [Not] later than the 30th  
1-25 day after the date the commission receives notice under Subsection  
1-26 (a) or obtains independent knowledge of groundwater contamination,  
1-27 the commission shall make every effort to give notice of the  
1-28 contamination by first class mail, e-mail, notice placed on the  
1-29 door of a residence, or another effective delivery method to:

1-30 (1) each owner of a private drinking water well that  
1-31 may be affected by the contamination;

1-32 (2) ~~and to~~ each applicable groundwater conservation  
1-33 district; and

1-34 (3) the residents of each residential address within  
1-35 one mile of the site of the contamination.

1-36 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.

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
