1-17 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
1-18 AN ACT

1-19 relating to the confidentiality of certain information collected by
1-20 certain local governments and airport governing boards.

1-21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-22 SECTION 1. Section 22.028, Transportation Code, is amended
1-23 to read as follows:

1-24 Sec. 22.028. CONFIDENTIALITY OF CERTAIN INFORMATION
1-25 COLLECTED BY LOCAL GOVERNMENT. Personal identifying information
1-26 collected by a local government is confidential and not subject to
1-27 disclosure under Chapter 552, Government Code, if the information
1-28 collected is in relation to a person's use of an airport ~~parking~~
1-29 facility that includes:

1-30 (1) the person's name, address, e-mail address, phone
1-31 number, and zip code;

1-32 (2) the person's license plate number, toll tag
1-33 number, and credit, debit, or other payment card number; ~~or~~

1-34 (3) the dates the person's vehicle was parked at a
1-35 parking ~~the~~ facility, the date the person's vehicle exited the
1-36 parking facility, and the amount the person paid to park in the
1-37 parking facility;

1-38 (4) the person's profile name associated with a
1-39 purchase or other online or in-person activity;

1-40 (5) the person's travel dates and flight information;

1-41 (6) the dates, times, and amounts of any purchase made
1-42 by the person; or

1-43 (7) the person's airport lounge memberships and
1-44 trusted traveler information.

1-45 SECTION 2. Section 22.091, Transportation Code, is amended
1-46 to read as follows:

1-47 Sec. 22.091. CONFIDENTIALITY OF CERTAIN INFORMATION
1-48 COLLECTED BY JOINT BOARD. Personal identifying information
1-49 collected by a joint board for which the constituent agencies are
1-50 populous home-rule municipalities is confidential and not subject
1-51 to disclosure under Chapter 552, Government Code, if the
1-52 information collected is in relation to:

1-53 (1) a commercial online payment system and includes a
1-54 person's:

1-55 (A) name, address, e-mail address, or phone
1-56 number;

1-57 (B) account number, password, payment
1-58 transaction activity, toll or charge record, or credit, debit, or
1-59 other payment card number; or

1-60 (C) other personal financial information; or

1-61 (2) a person's use of an airport ~~parking~~ facility

that includes:

(A) the person's name, address, e-mail address, phone number, and zip code;

(B) the person's license plate number, toll tag number, and credit, debit, or other payment card number; ~~or~~

(C) the dates the person's vehicle was parked at a parking ~~the~~ facility, the date the person's vehicle exited the parking facility, and the amount the person paid to park in the parking facility;

(D) the person's profile name associated with a purchase or other online or in-person activity;

(E) the person's travel dates and flight information;

(F) the dates, times, and amounts of any purchase made by the person; or

(G) the person's airport lounge memberships and trusted traveler information.

SECTION 3. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to a request for public information received by a governmental body or an officer for public information on or after the effective date of this Act.

SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
