1-17 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

1-19 relating to the authority of the Texas Department of Transportation
1-20 to settle certain claims.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

SECTION 1. Section 201.106(b), Transportation Code, is amended to read as follows:

- (b) The department may settle a claim described by Subsection (a) if:
- (1) the department may be liable under Chapter 101, Civil Practice and Remedies Code;
- (2) the director determines that a settlement is in the best interest of the department; and
- 1-30 (3) the department's liability under the terms of the 1-31 settlement is less than $\frac{100,000}{1}$.
- 1-32 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
