1-16 AN ACT

1-17 relating to the voluntary disclosure by an applicant for
1-18 registration of a motor vehicle of the applicant's military status.
1-19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
1-20 SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 502, Transportation Code,
1-21 is amended by adding Section 502.013 to read as follows:
1-22 Sec. 502.013. VOLUNTARY DISCLOSURE OF MILITARY STATUS BY
1-23 REGISTRATION APPLICANT. (a) When a person registers or renews the
1-24 registration of a motor vehicle under this chapter, the department
1-25 shall provide the person with the option to indicate whether the
1-26 person is a member of the United States armed forces.
1-27 (b) If a person indicates under Subsection (a) that the
1-28 person is a member of the United States armed forces, the department
1-29 shall include the person's status as a member of the United States
1-30 armed forces:
1-31 (1) in the department's vehicle registration records
1-32 for the vehicle described by Subsection (a); and
1-33 (2) with any record information released by the
1-34 department relating to the department's vehicle registration
1-35 records for the vehicle described by Subsection (a), including a
1-36 report issued by the department for the vehicle.
1-37 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
