1-19 relating to the duty of an appraisal district to keep confidential
1-20 certain identifying information provided by a property owner.
1-21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
1-22 SECTION 1. Section [11.48](#)(a), Tax Code, is amended to read as
1-23 follows:
1-24 (a) A driver's license number, personal identification
1-25 certificate number, or social security account number, or the name,
1-26 age, home address, or home telephone number of a child, provided in
1-27 an application for an exemption filed with a chief appraiser is
1-28 confidential and not open to public inspection. The information
1-29 may not be disclosed to anyone other than an employee or agent of
1-30 the appraisal district who appraises property or performs appraisal
1-31 services for the appraisal district, except as authorized by
1-32 Subsection (b).
1-33 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.

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
