relating to providing notice to a state representative and senator of certain administrative actions of the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

SECTION 1. Section 7.060, Water Code, is amended to read as follows:

Sec. 7.060. NOTICE OF PENALTY. (a) If the commission is required to give notice of a penalty under Section 7.057 or 7.059, the commission shall:

- (1) publish notice of its decision in the Texas Register not later than the 10th day after the date on which the decision is adopted; and
- (2) if required by Subsection (b), notify the state representative and state senator who represent the area where the violation for which the penalty is being assessed occurred.

 (1) affirmatively offer each state representative and state senator the opportunity to receive notice under Subsection
- provide appropriate notice to each representative or senator who elects to receive notice under this section.
 SECTION 2. Section 7.075, Water Code, is ame
