1-17 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
1-18 AN ACT

1-19 relating to transfer of the ownership rights of the Woodlawn Water  
1-20 Supply Corporation to the Angelina and Neches River Authority.

1-21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-22 SECTION 1. DEFINITIONS. In this Act:

1-23 (1) "Authority" means the Angelina and Neches River  
1-24 Authority.

1-25 (2) "Corporation" means the Woodlawn Water Supply  
1-26 Corporation.

1-27 SECTION 2. TRANSFER OF WATER SUPPLY CORPORATION; ASSETS;  
1-28 DISSOLUTION. (a) The authority may enter into a contract with the  
1-29 corporation to transfer the assets, debts, and contractual rights  
1-30 and obligations of the corporation to the authority.

1-31 (b) On the date a contract is executed as provided by  
1-32 Subsection (a) of this section:

1-33 (1) all real property, easements, appurtenances,  
1-34 conveyance systems, transmission and treatment systems, designated  
1-35 rights-of-way, and other property interests of the corporation are  
1-36 transferred to the authority;

1-37 (2) Certificate of Convenience and Necessity  
1-38 No. 10354 is considered to be held by the authority; and

1-39 (3) the board of directors of the corporation shall  
1-40 notify:

1-41 (A) the Texas Commission on Environmental  
1-42 Quality of the transfer of the corporation to the authority; and

1-43 (B) the Public Utility Commission of Texas of the  
1-44 transfer of Certificate of Convenience and Necessity No. 10354 to  
1-45 the authority.

1-46 (c) On receipt of notice under Subsection (b)(3)(B) of this  
1-47 section, the Public Utility Commission of Texas shall note in its  
1-48 records that Certificate of Convenience and Necessity No. 10354 is  
1-49 held by the authority and shall reissue the certificate in the name  
1-50 of the authority without further application, notice, or hearing.  
1-51 A person, party, or entity does not have any right of protest,  
1-52 objection, or administrative review of the transfer prescribed by  
1-53 this section.

1-54 (d) Not later than 30 days after the date of the transfer  
1-55 under Subsection (b) of this section, the board of directors of the  
1-56 corporation shall commence dissolution proceedings of the  
1-57 corporation.

1-58 SECTION 3. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Act takes effect  
1-59 immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members  
1-60 elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas
