1-19 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
1-20 AN ACT

1-21 relating to the installation of a filtration system by certain
1-22 public drinking water supply systems.
1-23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
1-24 SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 341, Health and Safety
1-25 Code, is amended by adding Section 341.0365 to read as follows:
1-26 Sec. 341.0365. FILTRATION SYSTEMS FOR CERTAIN UNDERGROUND
1-27 SOURCES. The commission by order may require a public drinking
1-28 water supply system that serves fewer than 100 connections and
1-29 obtains its water supply from an underground source to install a
1-30 filtration system for that source if the public water system:
1-31 (1) has repeatedly exceeded the maximum contaminant
1-32 level or secondary constituent level for one or more parameters
1-33 established by the commission and the United States Environmental
1-34 Protection Agency;
1-35 (2) has been the subject of more than one
1-36 substantiated water quality complaint submitted to the commission
1-37 during the preceding 12 months; and
1-38 (3) can install at a reasonable cost the filtration
1-39 system for that source to manage an exceedance of a secondary
1-40 constituent level, if applicable.
1-41 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
