370A.104. PROHIBITION ON CERTAIN INDEPENDENT SCHOOL Sec DISTRICT CAMPUS LOCATIONS. (a) An independent school district may not locate a new campus within 1,500 feet of a facility:

(1) that is providing navigation services; and

(2) at which the service provider operating facility intends to provide navigation services at the time the new independent school district campus is open to students.

(b) An independent school district may not reopen a closed campus or other property serving students of the district if the campus or other property is located within 1,500 feet of a facility providing navigation services.

(c) A school district board of trustees shall consult with

the task force to implement this section.

SECTION 2. As soon as practicable after the effective date of this Act, the governor shall appoint members to the safe schools and neighborhoods task force established by Section 370A.051, Local Government Code, as added by this Act.

SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
