SUBCHAPTER E. PRACTICE BY CERTIFICATE HOLDER

Sec. 1604.201. AUTHORIZED ACTIVITIES. A certificate issued under this chapter:

(1) authorizes the certificate holder to perform only cosmetic procedures; and

(2) does not authorize the certificate holder to treat, or offer to treat any client for any illness, diagn<u>ose,</u> disease, or injury of the human body.

SECTION 2. (a) Not later than December 1, 2025, the Texas Commission of Licensing and Regulation shall adopt the rules, forms, and fees necessary to administer Chapter 1604, Occupations Code, as added by this Act.

(b) Not later than March 1, 2026, the Texas Department of Licensing and Regulation shall approve the training required under Section 1604.151, Occupations Code, as added by this Act.

SECTION 3. (a) Except as provided by Subsection (b) of this section, this Act takes effect September 1, 2025.

(b) Section 1604.101, Occupations Code, as added by this Act, takes effect September 1, 2026.
