1-20 AN ACT

1-21 relating to the licensing and regulation of persons who may repair
1-22 or test backflow prevention assemblies.
1-23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
1-24 SECTION 1. Section [341.034\(c\)](#), Health and Safety Code, is
1-25 amended to read as follows:
1-26 (c) A person who repairs or tests the installation or
1-27 operation of backflow prevention assemblies must:
1-28 (1) hold a license issued by the commission under
1-29 Chapter [37](#), Water Code; or
1-30 (2) hold a certification issued by a nationally
1-31 recognized accrediting organization qualifying the person to test
1-32 backflow prevention assemblies.
1-33 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
