A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

SECTION 1. Section 244.003, Human Resources Code, is amended by amending Subsection (b) and adding Subsection (c) to read as follows:

- (b) Except as provided by Section 243.051(c), these records and all other information concerning a child, including personally identifiable information, are not public and are available only according to the provisions of <u>Subsection</u> (c) of this section, Section 58.005, Family Code, Section 244.051 of this code, and Chapter 67, Code of Criminal Procedure.

  (c) The department may disclose information concerning a
- person who was committed to the department, including personally identifiable information, if:

the person:
(A) has been discharged from commitment by the

department;
