1-19 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
1-20 AN ACT

1-21 relating to the route designation for a permit for the movement of
1-22 oversize and overweight vehicles that serve a deepwater seaport in
1-23 a county that borders the United Mexican States.

1-24 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-25 SECTION 1. Section 623.219(a), Transportation Code, is
1-26 amended to read as follows:

1-27 (a) For a permit issued by a port authority located in a
1-28 county that borders the United Mexican States, the commission
1-29 shall, with the consent of the port authority, designate the most
1-30 direct route:

1-31 (1) between [from]:

1-32 (A) [(1)] the Gateway International Bridge or
1-33 the Veterans International Bridge at Los Tomates and [to] the
1-34 entrance of the Port of Brownsville using:

1-35 (i) State Highways 48 and 4;

1-36 (ii) [or] United States Highways 77 and 83;

1-37 or

1-38 (iii) [using] United States Highway 77,

1-39 and United States Highway 83, East Loop Corridor, and State
1-40 Highway 4; and

1-41 (B) [(2)] the Free Trade International Bridge

1-42 and [to]

1-43 [(A)] the entrance of the Port of Brownsville
1-44 using Farm-to-Market Road 509, United States Highways 77 and 83,
1-45 Farm-to-Market Road 511, State Highway 550, and East Loop (State
1-46 Highway 32); and

1-47 (2) from the Free Trade International Bridge to:

1-48 (A) [(B)] the eastern entrance of the Port of
1-49 Harlingen using Farm-to-Market Road 509, United States Highway 77
1-50 Business, and Farm-to-Market Road 1846;

1-51 (B) [(C)] the western entrance of the Port of

1-52 Harlingen using Farm-to-Market Roads 509 and 106;

1-53 (C) [(D)] the southern entrance of the Harlingen

1-54 Industrial Park using Farm-to-Market Road 509; and

1-55 (D) [(E)] the southern entrance of the Harlingen

1-56 Aerotropolis at Valley International Airport using Farm-to-Market

1-57 Road 509.

1-58 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
