1-15 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
1-16 AN ACT

1-17 relating to supporting vouchers and other documents attached to
1-18 annual accounts filed by guardians of the estate.

1-19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-20 SECTION 1. Section 1163.003(a), Estates Code, is amended to
1-21 read as follows:

1-22 (a) The guardian of the estate shall attach to each annual
1-23 account:

1-24 (1) a voucher, including a receipt, invoice, or proof
1-25 of payment, for each item of credit claimed in the account or, to
1-26 support the item in the absence of the voucher, other evidence
1-27 satisfactory to the court;

1-28 (2) an official letter from the bank or other
1-29 depository where the money on hand of the estate or ward is
1-30 deposited that shows the amounts in general or special deposits;
1-31 ~~and~~

1-32 (3) proof of the existence and possession of:

1-33 (A) securities owned by the estate or shown by
1-34 the account; and

1-35 (B) other assets held by a depository subject to
1-36 court order;

1-37 (4) an official statement that covers the date that
1-38 the accounting period ends issued by each bank or other depository
1-39 where:

1-40 (A) the money on hand of the estate or ward is
1-41 deposited; or

1-42 (B) the securities or other assets are held for
1-43 safekeeping; and

1-44 (5) a bill of sale, contract, or other agreement
1-45 evidencing the sale of personal property of the estate or ward
1-46 during the accounting period.

1-47 SECTION 2. Section 1163.003, Estates Code, as amended by
1-48 this Act, applies to a guardianship proceeding that is pending or
1-49 commenced on or after the effective date of this Act.

1-50 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
