1-19 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
1-20 AN ACT

1-21 relating to the regulation of steroid use by students participating  
1-22 in athletic competitions sponsored or sanctioned by the University  
1-23 Interscholastic League.

1-24 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-25 SECTION 1. Section 33.091(h), Education Code, is amended to  
1-26 read as follows:

1-27 (h) Subsection (b)(1) does not apply to the use by a student  
1-28 of a steroid that is dispensed, prescribed, delivered, and  
1-29 administered by a medical practitioner for a valid medical purpose  
1-30 and in the course of professional practice, and a student is not  
1-31 subject to a period of ineligibility under Subsection (d)(6) on the  
1-32 basis of that steroid use. A valid medical purpose does not include  
1-33 the provision of steroids to a minor student to transition the  
1-34 student's biological sex.

1-35 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives  
1-36 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as  
1-37 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this  
1-38 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this  
1-39 Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
