1-19 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
1-20 AN ACT

1-21 relating to the eligibility of children of certain elected
1-22 officials to participate in an education savings account program.

1-23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-24 SECTION 1. Chapter 29, Education Code, is amended by adding
1-25 Subchapter J to read as follows:

1-26 SUBCHAPTER J. EDUCATION SAVINGS ACCOUNT PROGRAM

1-27 Sec. 29.3511. DEFINITION OF PROGRAM. For purposes of
1-28 Section 29.3551, "program" means the education savings account
1-29 program established under S.B. 2, Acts of the 89th Legislature,
1-30 Regular Session, 2025. This section expires September 1, 2026.

1-31 Sec. 29.3551. ELIGIBILITY OF CHILDREN OF CERTAIN ELECTED
1-32 OFFICIALS. Notwithstanding any other provision of this subchapter,
1-33 a child is not eligible to participate in the program during the
1-34 period in which the child's parent or legal guardian is a state
1-35 representative, state senator, or statewide elected official.

1-36 SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2026-2027
1-37 school year.

1-38 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
1-39 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
1-40 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
1-41 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
1-42 Act takes effect September 1, 2025.

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
