1-15 SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

1-16 WHEREAS, Pflugerville boasts an expansive trail network that  
1-17 provides residents and visitors with ample opportunities for  
1-18 exercise, recreation, and social connection; and

1-19 WHEREAS, Currently, Pflugerville maintains 56 miles of  
1-20 public trails within its city limits as well as an additional 15.2  
1-21 miles in its extraterritorial jurisdiction, totaling more than 71  
1-22 miles of accessible paths; an analysis by city staff has found that  
1-23 Pflugerville has more public trails per capita than any other city  
1-24 in the state, with 1.49 miles per 2,000 residents; moreover, an  
1-25 estimated 94.8 percent of its citizens live within a half mile of a  
1-26 trail, and 70 percent use the trails regularly; and

1-27 WHEREAS, Pflugerville's trail network meets robust safety  
1-28 standards and features parking, lighting, and restrooms along major  
1-29 routes, ensuring a safe and convenient experience for trail users  
1-30 of all ages; in addition to facilitating access to green spaces, the  
1-31 trails serve as a hub for a wide variety of cultural activities,  
1-32 including community events, recreational programming, and public  
1-33 art installations; the pathways also help to reduce traffic  
1-34 congestion by connecting local neighborhoods, schools, and  
1-35 businesses; and

1-36 WHEREAS, The trail network in Pflugerville has made the city  
1-37 a popular destination for Texans who enjoy active lifestyles, and  
1-38 the city is indeed deserving of special recognition for its  
1-39 steadfast commitment to enhancing the health and well-being of the  
1-40 community; now, therefore, be it

1-41 RESOLVED, That the 89th Legislature of the State of Texas  
1-42 hereby designate Pflugerville as the official Trail Capital of  
1-43 Texas; and, be it further

1-44 RESOLVED, That, in accordance with the provisions of Section  
1-45 391.003(e), Government Code, this designation remain in effect  
1-46 until the 10th anniversary of the date this resolution is finally  
1-47 passed by the legislature.
