1-15 SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

1-16 WHEREAS, El Paso has long been known for its rich cultural  
 1-17 heritage, dynamic economy, and distinctive traditions, and it has  
 1-18 gained a global reputation as a center for boot making; and

1-19 WHEREAS, The city is home to iconic boot manufacturers such  
 1-20 as Lucchese, Rocketbuster, Caboots, and Tony Lama, along with a  
 1-21 host of other renowned businesses that have contributed to  
 1-22 El Paso's growing influence as a leader in producing premier  
 1-23 Western footwear; and

1-24 WHEREAS, El Paso's array of boot makers includes multiple  
 1-25 companies that have been in operation for more than a century, and  
 1-26 the craftspeople who power the industry have proven their mastery  
 1-27 of techniques that have been passed down for generations; and

1-28 WHEREAS, In addition to producing products of exceptional  
 1-29 quality, these businesses fuel the local economy, create jobs, and  
 1-30 attract visitors from around the world to witness the handiwork of  
 1-31 the city's artisans; and

1-32 WHEREAS, Through their dedication to the preservation and  
 1-33 promotion of their trade, the boot makers of El Paso have elevated  
 1-34 the craft and furthered the cultural and artistic identity of the  
 1-35 Lone Star State, and the city's role in promoting the continued  
 1-36 vitality of this time-honored and uniquely Texan tradition is  
 1-37 indeed deserving of recognition; now, therefore, be it

1-38 RESOLVED, That the 89th Legislature of the State of Texas  
 1-39 hereby designate El Paso as the official Boot Capital of Texas; and,  
 1-40 be it further

1-41 RESOLVED, That, in accordance with the provisions of Section  
 1-42 391.003(e), Government Code, this designation remain in effect  
 1-43 until the 10th anniversary of the date this resolution is finally  
 1-44 passed by the legislature.
