1-19 SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

1-20 WHEREAS, Human beings are born male or female, with such  
1-21 biological identity being immutable and innate; and  
1-22 WHEREAS, Even in our great state, ideologues put forth a  
1-23 false narrative that denies this fundamental truth, using lawfare,  
1-24 coercion, and fear to deny women the rights and protections to which  
1-25 they are entitled; and  
1-26 WHEREAS, Across the country, such falsehoods have allowed men  
1-27 to self-identify as women and enter spaces designed for the  
1-28 protection of women, such as women's shelters and women's  
1-29 bathrooms; and  
1-30 WHEREAS, Sex is an immutable characteristic that can be  
1-31 readily identified, and attacks on the definition of sex are  
1-32 baseless; now, therefore, be it  
1-33 RESOLVED, By the 89th Legislature of the State of Texas, That  
1-34 it is the policy of the state to recognize two sexes, male and  
1-35 female; and, be it further  
1-36 RESOLVED, That the State of Texas will defend women's rights  
1-37 by using clear and accurate language and policies recognizing that  
1-38 women are biologically female and men are biologically male.
