1-17 SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

1-18 WHEREAS, The Gulf Coast Protection District is essential to  
1-19 accomplish the purposes of Section 59, Article XVI, Texas  
1-20 Constitution, and for protecting the coast in Chambers, Galveston,  
1-21 Harris, Jefferson, and Orange Counties and territory annexed to the  
1-22 district; and

1-23 WHEREAS, The Texas Legislature has authorized the Gulf Coast  
1-24 Protection District, in fulfilling its duties, to manage coastal  
1-25 barriers, improve seawalls, establish environmental mitigation  
1-26 facilities, and provide interior drainage remediation to the  
1-27 region; and

1-28 WHEREAS, In establishing and managing these projects, the  
1-29 Gulf Coast Protection District should prioritize the safety and  
1-30 continued economic activity of the region; now, therefore, be it

1-31 RESOLVED, That the 89th Legislature of the State of Texas  
1-32 hereby urge the Gulf Coast Protection District and the U.S. Army  
1-33 Corps of Engineers to not compromise navigation safety or two-way  
1-34 traffic vessel movement when implementing a project authorized by  
1-35 the legislature under Section 9502.0301(a), Special District Local  
1-36 Laws Code; and, be it further

1-37 RESOLVED, That the Texas secretary of state forward an  
1-38 official copy of this resolution to the Gulf Coast Protection  
1-39 District and to the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers.
