BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

SECTION 1. Section 1(a), Article VI, Texas Constitution, is amended to read as follows:

- (a) The following classes of persons shall not be allowed to vote in this State:
 - (1)persons under 18 years of age;
- 1-27 1-28 (2) persons who have been determined mentally incompetent by a court, subject to such exceptions as the 1-29 1-30 Legislature may make; [and]
 - (3) persons convicted of any felony, subject to such exceptions as the Legislature may make; and
- 1-33 (4) persons who are not citizens of the United States. SECTION 2. This proposed constitutional amendment shall be 1-34 1-35 submitted to the voters at an election to be held November 4, 2025. The ballot shall be printed to permit voting for or against the proposition: "The constitutional amendment clarifying that a voter 1-36 1-37 1-38 must be a United States citizen."
