1-23 SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION

1-24 proposing a constitutional amendment prohibiting the use of state  
1-25 funds to pay for the obligations of a local public retirement  
1-26 system.

1-27 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-28 SECTION 1. Section 67, Article XVI, Texas Constitution, is  
1-29 amended by adding Subsection (c-1) to read as follows:

1-30 (c-1) This state is not liable for any debts or other  
1-31 obligations of a retirement system described by Subsection (c) of  
1-32 this section. The legislature may not appropriate money to a  
1-33 retirement system described by Subsection (c) of this section to  
1-34 pay any debts or other obligations of the retirement system.

1-35 SECTION 2. This proposed constitutional amendment shall be  
1-36 submitted to the voters at an election to be held November 4, 2025.  
1-37 The ballot shall be printed to permit voting for or against the  
1-38 proposition: "The constitutional amendment prohibiting the  
1-39 legislature from appropriating state money to a local public  
1-40 retirement system to pay any debts or other obligations of the  
1-41 retirement system."
