1           WHEREAS, Kevin Engle marked the 10th anniversary of his  
2 tenure as executive director of Stewards Foundation on April 25,  
3 2004; and

4           WHEREAS, Before accepting the position at the helm of  
5 Stewards Foundation, Mr. Engle had a career in sales and marketing  
6 for several years; he had also served in the U.S. Navy aboard the  
7 USS *White Plains* and the USS *Sperry*; after a brief time in the U.S.  
8 Naval Reserve in Kansas, he received an honorable discharge and  
9 later enrolled in The University of Texas at Dallas to complete a  
10 degree in psychology; and

11           WHEREAS, His work at Stewards Foundation has had a great  
12 impact in many parts of the nation; founded in 1945, the  
13 not-for-profit corporation provides the necessary funding for  
14 Plymouth Brethren Christian congregations in the construction,  
15 improvement, or purchase of church buildings and facilities  
16 throughout the country; the organization was originally  
17 established in Chicago, Illinois, and, under the leadership of Mr.  
18 Engle, recently relocated to Texas; and

19           WHEREAS, The son of missionaries, Mr. Engle grew up in the  
20 Lord's work and has a desire to serve the Lord and the Lord's people;  
21 through his decade-long work at Stewards Foundation, he has hewed  
22 to his parents' tenets and has been of invaluable service to  
23 countless many; now, therefore, be it
