R E S O L U T I O N

1 WHEREAS, Maria de Jesus Guevara was inducted into the El Paso
2 Commission for Women Hall of Fame on March 9, 2007; and

3 WHEREAS, Established in 1985, the commission is composed of
4 El Paso citizens who are committed to the pursuit of equal rights
5 and responsibilities for all women; inductees to the organization's
6 Hall of Fame are recognized in one of five categories, including
7 professional and public service, arts, education, and civic
8 leadership; and

9 WHEREAS, Selected for the public service category, "Chita"
10 Guevara has dedicated her time to such organizations as MADD and the
11 HOPE Victim Support Group in an effort to curtail drunk driving and
12 to support those individuals and their families whose lives have
13 been affected by its tragic results; and

15 the State of Texas depend on the dedication of women like Maria de
16 Jesus Guevara; she uses her considerable talents and generous
17 spirit to serve others, and it is a pleasure to join the commission
18 in honoring her; now, therefore, be it

20 Legislature hereby congratulate Maria de Jesus Guevara on her
21 induction into the El Paso Commission for Women Hall of Fame and
