**IN RE: HB2112** by Patrick (Relating to the prosecution of an offense prohibiting the exhibition, use, or threatened exhibition or use of a firearm in or on school property or a school bus. ),  
**Committee Report 1st House, Substituted**

**No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.**

The bill would amend the exhibition of firearms penal provision of the Education Code by further defining the offense of exhibition of firearms. The offense of exhibition of firearms is punishable as a felony of the third degree.

It is assumed that the bill would not significantly affect the operations of state or local government.

**Local Government Impact**

No significant fiscal implication to units of local government is anticipated.
