2	relating to certain content requirements for signs used to identify
3	the location of a polling place during a primary election.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subchapter E, Chapter 172, Election Code, is
6	amended by adding Section 172.127 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 172.127. CONTENT OF SIGN USED TO IDENTIFY POLLING
8	PLACE LOCATION. (a) This section applies only to a polling place
9	used to hold an election for more than one political party.
10	(b) A sign used to indicate the location of a polling place
11	for a primary election or a primary runoff election must either:
12	(1) not contain the name of, or symbol representing,
13	any political party that is holding an election at the polling
14	place; or
15	(2) contain each name of, or each symbol representing,
16	a political party that is holding an election at the polling place.

SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
